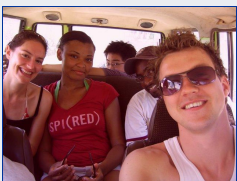

The volunteer

Life Bridge is looking for a volunteer to help them with their fundraising. They require the potential volunteer to develop a sustainable and long-term fundraising initiative. The volunteer will be required to do some or all of the following:

- Plan, develop and establish policies and objectives of fundraising in accordance with objectives of organization.
- Compile and analyze information about potential contributors to develop mailing or contact list.
- Contact and visit potential contributors and persuades them to contribute funds or gifts-in-kind by explaining purpose and benefits of fund raising program.
- Work closely with and train Life Bridge staff to ensure sustainability of the fundraising program.
- Record expenses incurred and contributions received.
- Plan social functions to raise funds.

What kind of skills you need to go on this placement

The volunteer will need to be very outgoing, patient and sociable. You will need to be flexible and tolerant, show initiative and enthusiasm to face the many hurdles and challenges that you will encounter. You will have to be able to cope with simple working conditions and be able to work with little resources. The ideal candidate will have experience with marketing, business, project coordination or fundraising.

Project Duration	Min Duration 4 weeks - Max Duration 26 weeks (can be extended in-country).
Dates	You can volunteer at any time throughout the year.

Accommodation Details

The individual will be staying at the Ikando accommodation in central Accra and travelling daily to the organisation located in the outskirts of the city. The house is clean and well-furnished, with running water and electricity (most of the time). You may be required to share your room with other Ikando volunteers. There is 24-hour Ikando staff at the house. A cleaner will be available a couple of times a week to clean the accommodation and wash and iron your clothes for you.

- 24/7 Emergency support.
- Introduction to life in Ghana.

What's not included?
